APL2017-0006 An Administrative Appeal application by **Sudden Valley Community Association** of a NOAR determination made by **Whatcom County Planning and Development Services**, issued on June 29, 2017, which indicated that Whatcom County viewed the Typical Full Road Rebuild and the Full Depth Patch as meeting the definition of "Replaced Impervious Surface," [WCC 20.97.342], and, therefore, would require a "phosphorus neutral" stormwater plan with WCC 20.51.420(2)(c) or (d). The Appellants' believe this interpretation of County Code is inconsistent with both the Whatcom County Code and the Department of Ecology's 2012 Stormwater Manual for Western Washington regarding the project's proposed maintenance and repair activities, located within multiple sites in Sudden Valley ROW.
