Hosted by the Lummi Island Ferry Advisory Committee (LIFAC), a meeting has been scheduled for KPFF Consulting and Whatcom County Public Works to present information of interest to the Lummi Island community.

As part of the Ferry System Improvement Project, one of the most important factors is determining the desired level of service (LOS) and the size of the replacement vessel required to meet that LOS. During the meeting, information will be presented on the current service levels provided by the Whatcom Chief (to establish the baseline), projected average ridership (vehicles and passengers) into the future, and the differing numbers of vehicles transported and number of runs that can be accommodated by three vessel replacement options during the peak periods of those future years. This information will assist the community, LIFAC and Whatcom County in determining the appropriate LOS and the corresponding size of the replacement vessel to recommend to the Whatcom County Council.

This will be an important meeting. We hope to see you there!
