

## MINUTES – BPAC Meeting May 18, 2016

1. Comprehensive Plan update – Gary Davis
  - Rud Browne proposed additions to Comp Plan @ County Council mtg last night
  - Gary is working on a broader policy in the multi-modal section
  - Final Comp Plan should be approved end of July 2016
  - Motion made to invite Rud Browne to next meeting to discuss his proposed additions
2. Marine Bridge sign project update – Rodney Vandersypen
  - 100% design is completed – going out for bid June 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Hope for construction by July
  - Sign reads: “Narrow shoulder. Watch for bikes” and flashes when anything under 20mph passes detector
3. Proposed new trails – Tenneset Lake – Daniel Tepper
  - Extending the boardwalk trail
  - Adjunct trail to the Nooksack Loop Trail/Hovander Park
4. Invite Jon Hutchings to next meeting?
  - Daniel Tepper suggested inviting Jon Hutchings, Public Works Director, to our next meeting
  - Committee agreed it would be a good idea, as the last time he attended our meeting was in November 2015. It would be good to touch base with him. Members to meet beforehand to discuss talking points and questions for Mr. Hutchings.
5. “Recreation” vs. “Transportation” – Daniel
  - Daniel Tepper frustrated that County Council still seems to be unclear in what distinguishes “recreation” from “transportation” with respect to bike/ped routes
  - Rodney suggested that BPAC come up with a definition to help guide government/politicians/public in making decisions of responsibility, etc.
