Run with the Chums is a fun and free event for all ages to celebrate healthy water and healthy people. Run or walk on a scenic loop through the highlands above Cherry Point Aquatic Reserve and Point Whitehorn, and learn more about watershed health while taking care of your own health! The 5K route explores forested trails, opens up to coastal views, and finishes through agricultural land, celebrating the wide variety of resources that we have here in Whatcom County. A kids-only 1K Smolt Sprint features a salmon-themed obstacle course and will start at 10 am; all racers will receive a ribbon.

This year's Run with the Chums will have an additional focus on Orca recovery. Puget Sound's Southern Resident killer whales are critically endangered. The single biggest threat is a lack of their primary food source, salmon! Join local partners that are working in habitat recovery efforts to learn what we can all do to protect and recover this iconic species of the Pacific Northwest.

Registration is free and the first 300 participants will receive a free event t-shirt! From the mountains to the sea, we all rely on clean, fresh water for drinking, productive farmland, healthy fisheries, outdoor recreation and safe shellfish harvesting. Let's celebrate clean water and get healthy in the process!

Festivities before and after the race include refreshments, children's activities, and hands-on exhibits. Be sure to stay for the generous raffle following the 5K!
