For the second ballot, when the voter called to request a replacement his first envelope was pulled along with the envelope for his wife. The handwriting for both voters is very similar but it was determined that the wife did sign the first envelope with her name, (first initial last name) which is identical to his, and that she was signing a note on the envelope not signing his name to the ballot. When it was determined he had not signed the first envelope, a replacement was issued.
