A **Food System** is a network of people and activities connecting food production, food processing, distribution, consumption, and food waste management, as well as the associated inputs, influences, and policies.

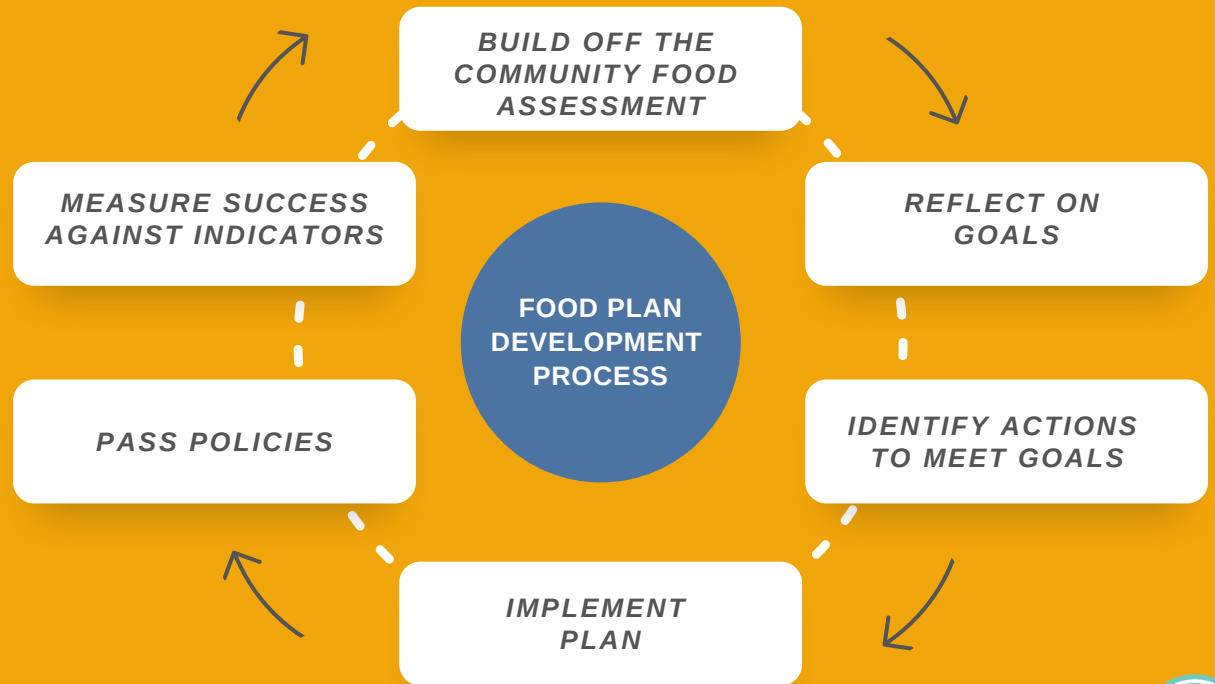
The **Whatcom County Food System Committee** is drafting a long-range food systems plan that will include action steps to strengthen the Whatcom County food system.
