If you seek medical help for someone having an overdose, neither of you can be charged for having or using a small amount of drugs.

WA State RCW 69.50.315

The Good Samaritan Overdose Law protects you!

CALL 911

The Good Samaritan Law does not apply to:

- outstanding warrants
- controlled substances homicide
- other crimes besides drug possession
- probation or parole violations
- drug manufacture or delivery

In these cases, a judge can give you a shorter sentence.
